How do I activate the USB drivers for Endeavour[®] 5 Navigator 5.5 for VISTA?

Using the “Found New Hardware” prompt

If Endeavour has already been installed, when the USB dongle is attached for first time it opens the “Found New Hardware” window:

1. Choose the **Locate and install Driver software** option
2. Choose the **Don't search online** option
3. Choose the **Browse my computer for driver software** option
4. To locate the correct folder, click **Browse** to find c:\Program Files\Dallas Semiconductor\1-Wire Drivers 4.01Beta Version 4.01Beta
5. Click **Next** and select the **Install this driver software anyway** option.
6. When complete, click **Close** and a message should appear saying “USB Host Adapter for I-Wire network” was successfully installed.

OR

Finding files though *My Computer*

If the “Found New Hardware” prompt was cancelled, (after Endeavour has been installed) then

1. Click the Start Button, highlight *COMPUTER* and Right Click with the mouse to select the *Properties* > **Device Manager** task.
2. On the “Device Manager” dialog under the *Other devices* – there should be an *Unknown device* entry with an icon which has Exclamation mark on a yellow background.
3. Right Mouse Button click on that entry and select **Update Driver Software...**
4. To locate the correct folder, click **Browse** to find c:\Program Files\Dallas Semiconductor\1-Wire Drivers 4.01Beta Version 4.01Beta
5. Click **Next** and select option **Install this software driver anyway**.
6. When complete, click **Close** and a message should appear saying “USB Host Adapter for I-Wire network” was successfully installed.
